Dr. McWhirter is the founder of the MTSU Bel Canto and director of the MTSU Women's Chorale. The MTSU Women's Chorale performed in the summer of 2009 at Carnegie Hall as part of the 70th Anniversary Gala Celebration of Shawnee Press and was invited to sing at St. Malachy's Cathedral. She has been named numerous times to Who's Who in America, Who's Who Among American Women, Who's Who Among America's Teachers, Who's Who in American Education and the National Chancellor's List. She is a member of Pi Kappa Lambda, ACDA, MENC, TMEA, MTVA, CMS, and a patroness member of Sigma Alpha Iota. Dr. McWhirter is in her 21st year of teaching, currently in her 5th year at MTSU.
